<u>Placement Assessment</u> - An assessment students take to gauge their level of knowledge in a subject.

New Student Action Plan

☐ Meet with your school counselor to determine if you are eligible

- ➤ Enrolled at Lakeland High School
- > 16+ years old
- ➤ Idaho Resident
- > 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA
- ➤ Minimum of ½ of HS credits completed

☐ Fill out the NIC Dual Credit Application

- ➤ Go to www.nic.edu/cardinalcentral
- > Click on the red button "Apply Now"
- Continue by following NIC's Enrollment steps

□ Dual Credit Authorization Form (Parent Step)

- ➤ An electronic form will be sent to the parent / guardian's email you listed on your application.
 - Parent/Guardian will need to complete the electronic form, saying that they are giving their student permission to become a NIC Dual Credit student.

□ Acceptance Letter from NIC

- > This letter will include your NIC Student ID
- > Includes directions on how to set up your NIC account
 - Please complete and write down your username and password for future reference.

☐ Take your Placement Test (www.nic.edu/testingcenter)

- > Writing Assessment (www.thewriteclassnic.com)
 - Must complete if planning to take an English or Communications class
 - Print or email results to your school counselor
- ➤ ALEKS Placement Test (proctored & taken on the NIC campus)
 - Requires a 3 hour practice session prior to taking the test
 - ONLY if you plan to take a science or math class the following semester
 - Print your results and bring to your counselor
 - For more information and directions regarding the placement test
